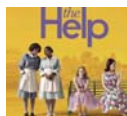
Indianola Parks & Recreation is beginning a master planning process for the enhancement and renovation of this cherished and historic park.

Movie Afternoon

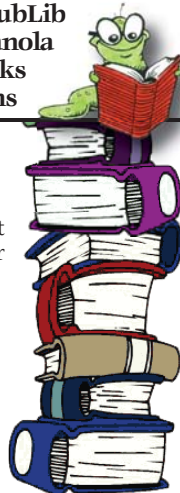
Sunday, January 15th • 1:00 p.m.

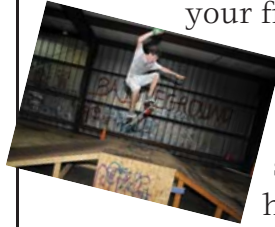
