WEEK OF APRIL 24-28 Curbside Pickup on Your Recycling Day

Please place your items on the curb by 7:00 am. **No regular recycling will be picked up this week. Instead, curbside pickup will take place.**

Spring Curbside Pickup allows Indianola residents to dispose of large household items, **except appliances**, at no additional charge.

(Appliance drop off available April 15 only - see above)

All smaller items must be placed in bags or boxes. Think of all the things you would like to get rid of during an intense cleaning: mattresses, couches, tables, chairs, doors, books, old dishes, or box springs.

Items that are bulky and difficult to handle (such as swing sets) must be cut up or dismantled into pieces no longer than 4 feet.

THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF DEBRIS ON YOUR CURB MUST FIT INTO THE SIZE OF A FLATBED TRUCK, ROUGHLY 8 FT X 5.5 FT X 3 FT. EXTRA DEBRIS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.

Items NOT accepted for curbside pickup include

appliances • broken glass • concrete • construction materials • electronic waste
hazardous waste • railroad ties • tires • yard waste

*Items from large construction projects will not be facilitated.
