Hello. I hope everybody is doing well.

We wanted to follow up with all of the neighborhood residents affected by the Apple Lane and Apple Drive sewer project. As Jim Mayne stated in his last email, the contractor (J&K Contracting) is scheduled to begin construction on Monday, March 19. However, due to the change in scope of the sewer project (explained in the December 19th *Morlock Gravity Sewer Improvements Clarification* email that Jim Mayne sent), the contractor has submitted a revised construction sequencing plan that is more appropriate and will potentially have less impact to the neighborhood. J&K's revised construction sequencing plan is as follows:

“Beginning on March 19th, Apple Lane will be closed to through traffic from 1808 Apple Lane to 1707 Apple Lane for construction of new sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and pavement. Crews will start construction at 1808 Apple Lane and work their way east along Apple Lane, eventually working past 1708 and 1710 Apple Drive. The work is expected to last approximately 5 weeks. Pavement will be removed daily to ensure forward progress of the project while offering access to those properties owners on the east end of Apple Lane for as long as possible. J&K and HR Green will notify homeowners directly as to when they will lose driveway access. Please see attached plan for potential parking locations.

We would ask that you please place all garbage and recycling containers at the end of your respective driveways on your normal pickup days and J&K will work directly with your refuse carrier to ensure proper collection.

Feel free to contact us (J&K Contracting) at 515-233-5500 if you have any questions or concerns, or if you have any issue with the collection of your waste. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this time.”

J&K is hand delivering door hangers with this information included along with a map that illustrates the proposed construction operations. The map is also attached to this email and shows designated on-street parking areas during times when your driveway may be inaccessible.
